



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2015

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2015 totaled 1.44 billion bushels, up 18 percent from March 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 660 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 777 million bushels. The December 2014 - February 2015 indicated disappearance is 463 million bushels, down 8 percent from the same period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2015 totaled 198 million bushels, up 30 percent from March 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 89.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 109 million bushels. The December 2014 - February 2015 indicated disappearance is 197 million bushels, down 8 percent from the same period last year.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2015 totaled 28.3 million bushels, up 3 percent from March 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 2.10 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 26.2 million bushels. The December 2014 - February 2015 indicated disappearance is 8.80 million bushels, up 2 percent from the same period last year.
