



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2015

Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 846 million bushels, up 49 percent from June 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 330 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 516 million bushels. The March - May 2015 indicated disappearance is 591 million bushels, down 9 percent from the same period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 93.6 million bushels, up 65 percent from June 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 35.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 58.6 million bushels. The March - May 2015 indicated disappearance is 105 million bushels, up 10 percent from the same period last year.

Old crop all wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2015 totaled 21.4 million bushels, up 93 percent from June 1, 2014. On-farm stocks totaled 1.39 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 20.0 million bushels. The March - May 2015 indicated disappearance is 6.79 million bushels, down 59 percent from the same period last year.
