



Illinois Small Grains 2015 Summary

Released September 30, 2015

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2015 is estimated at 520,000 acres, down 22 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at 65 bushels per acre, down 2 bushels from 2014. Production is estimated at 33.8 million bushels, 25 percent below the previous year.

Oats: Harvested area in 2015, at 25,000 acres, is unchanged from the previous year. The oat yield is estimated at 77 bushels per acre, down 3 bushels from 2014. Production is estimated at 1.93 million bushels, 4 percent below the previous year.
