



Illinois Cattle


Released January 29, 2016

All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2016 totaled 1.18 million head, 5 percent above January 1, 2015. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 490,000 head, were up 7 percent from January 1, 2015. The 2015 calf crop was estimated at 415,000 head, up 4 percent from 2014.
