



# Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2016

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 1.28 billion bushels, down 11 percent from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 580 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 697 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 546 million bushels, up 18 percent from the same period last year.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 239 million bushels, up 20 percent from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 115 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 124 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 214 million bushels, up 9 percent from the same period last year.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 24.9 million bushels, down 12 percent from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 1.70 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 23.2 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 7.69 million bushels, down 14 percent from the same period last year.
