



Illinois Crop Production

Released May 10, 2016

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2016 is forecast at 520,000 acres, the same as the previous year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 68 bushels per acre, up 3 bushels from 2015. Production is forecast at 35.4 million bushels, 5 percent above the previous year.
