



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released September 30, 2016

Old crop corn stocks in all positions on September 1, 2016 totaled 216 million bushels, down 30 percent from September 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 53.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 163 million bushels. The June - August 2016 indicated disappearance is 463 million bushels.

Old crop soybean stocks in all positions on September 1, 2016 totaled 27.5 million bushels, down 2 percent from September 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 7.40 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 20.1 million bushels. The June - August 2016 indicated disappearance is 112 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on September 1, 2016 totaled 40.6 million bushels, up 5 percent from September 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 5.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 35.1 million bushels. The June - August 2016 indicated disappearance is 11.1 million bushels.
