



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2017

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 1.97 billion bushels, up 8 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 1.05 billion bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 924 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 498 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 482 million bushels, up 6 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 230 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 252 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 138 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 42.5 million bushels, up 30 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 3.55 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 39.0 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 2.95 million bushels.
