Released January 31, 2017


All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2017 totaled 1.20 million head, 3 percent above January 1, 2016. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 480,000 head, were down 2 percent from January 1, 2016. The 2016 calf crop was estimated at 410,000 head, down 1 percent from 2015.
