



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2017

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 1.40 billion bushels, up 9 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 640 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 755 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 579 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 277 million bushels, up 16 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 94.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 183 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 205 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 36.5 million bushels, up 46 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 2.20 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 34.3 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 6.03 million bushels.
