



Illinois Crop Production

Released June 9, 2017

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2017 is forecast at 450,000 acres, down 4 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 73 bushels per acre, down 1 bushel from 2016. Production is forecast at 32.9 million bushels, 6 percent below the previous year.
