



# Illinois Hogs and Pigs

Released June 29, 2017

**Illinois inventory** of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2017 was 5.35 million head, up 2 percent from March 1, 2017 and up 3 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 530,000 head, was down 10,000 from the previous quarter but unchanged from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 4.82 million head, was up 2 percent from last quarter and up 3 percent from last year.

**The March-May 2017 pig crop**, at 2.80 million head, was up 5 percent from 2016. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 265,000 head, up 10,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.55 for the March-May period, compared with 10.40 last year.


