



Illinois Crop Production

Released July 12, 2017

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2017 is forecast at 490,000 acres, up 4 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 75 bushels per acre, up 1 bushel from 2016. If realized, this will be a record high yield. Production is forecast at 36.8 million bushels, 6 percent above the previous year.
