



# Illinois Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2018

**Corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2017 totaled 2.08 billion bushels, up 5 percent from December 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 1.10 billion bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 980 million bushels. The September - November 2017 indicated disappearance is 502 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2017 totaled 511 million bushels, up 6 percent from December 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 230 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 281 million bushels. The September - November 2017 indicated disappearance is 140 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2017 totaled 46.7 million bushels, up 10 percent from December 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 2.70 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 44.0 million bushels. The September - November 2017 indicated disappearance is 3.77 million bushels.
