



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released September 28, 2018

Old crop corn stocks in all positions on September 1, 2018 totaled 375 million bushels, down 1 percent from September 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 48.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 327 million bushels. The June - August 2018 indicated disappearance is 572 million bushels.

Old crop soybean stocks in all positions on September 1, 2018 totaled 86.2 million bushels, up 124 percent from September 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 12.4 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 73.8 million bushels. The June - August 2018 indicated disappearance is 164 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on September 1, 2018 totaled 45.7 million bushels, down 9 percent from September 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 3.90 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 41.8 million bushels. The June - August 2018 indicated disappearance is 19.9 million bushels.
