
All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2019 totaled 1.2 million head, 4 percent above January 1, 2018. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 500,000 head, are up 2 percent from a year ago. The 2018 calf crop was estimated at 430,000 head, up 2 percent from 2017.
