



# Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 29, 2019

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2019 totaled 1.55 billion bushels, down 6 percent from March 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 740 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 805 million bushels. The December 2018 - February 2019 indicated disappearance is 527 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2019 totaled 492 million bushels, up 31 percent from March 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 215 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 277 million bushels. The December 2018 - February 2019 indicated disappearance is 177 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2019 totaled 26.0 million bushels, down 34 percent from March 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 1.00 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 25.0 million bushels. The December 2018 - February 2019 indicated disappearance is 9.04 million bushels.
