



# Illinois Grain Stocks

Released September 30, 2019

**Old crop corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2019 totaled 419 million bushels, up 12 percent from September 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 110 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 309 million bushels. The June - August 2019 indicated disappearance is 546 million bushels.

**Old crop soybean** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2019 totaled 187 million bushels, up 117 percent from September 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 33.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 154 million bushels. The June - August 2019 indicated disappearance is 134 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2019 totaled 36.8 million bushels, down 20 percent from September 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 6.30 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 30.5 million bushels. The June - August 2019 indicated disappearance is 16.8 million bushels.
