



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released January 10, 2020

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2019 totaled 1.76 billion bushels, down 15 percent from December 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 930 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 834 million bushels. The September - November 2019 indicated disappearance is 530 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2019 totaled 586 million bushels, down 13 percent from December 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 265 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 321 million bushels. The September - November 2019 indicated disappearance is 134 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2019 totaled 23.4 million bushels, down 33 percent from December 1, 2018. On-farm stocks totaled 2.10 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 21.3 million bushels. The September - November 2019 indicated disappearance is 13.4 million bushels.
