



# Illinois Cattle

Released January 31, 2020


**All cattle and calves** as of January 1, 2020 totaled 1.10 million head, 8 percent below January 1, 2019. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 460,000 head, are down 6 percent from a year ago. The 2019 calf crop was estimated at 405,000 head, down 6 percent from 2018.
