



# Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2020

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 1.23 billion bushels, down 21 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 530 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 696 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 544 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 385 million bushels, down 22 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 155 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 230 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 202 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 15.2 million bushels, down 42 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 1.40 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 13.8 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 8.18 million bushels.
