



Illinois Hogs and Pigs

Released September 24, 2020

Illinois inventory of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 2020 was 5.40 million head, down 2 percent from June 1, 2020 and down 2 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 580,000 head, was up 10,000 from the previous quarter but down 10,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 4.82 million head, was down 2 percent from last quarter and down 2 percent from last year.

The June-August 2020 pig crop, at 3.05 million head, was down 4 percent from 2019. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 285,000 head, down 5,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.70 for the June-August period, compared with 10.95 last year.


