



## Released March 31, 2023

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2023 totaled 1.34 billion bushels, up 6 percent from March 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 620 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 716 million bushels. The December 2022 - February 2023 indicated disappearance is 643 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2023 totaled 270 million bushels, down 20 percent from March 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 125 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 145 million bushels. The December 2022 - February 2023 indicated disappearance is 276 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2023 totaled 19.4 million bushels, down 15 percent from March 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 1.25 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 18.1 million bushels. The December 2022 - February 2023 indicated disappearance is 10.6 million bushels.
