

## **Illinois Prospective Plantings**

## Released March 31, 2023

**Corn** growers intend to plant 11.0 million acres in 2023, up 2 percent from 2022. **Soybean** planted area is expected to total 10.8 million acres, unchanged from the previous year. **Winter wheat** area seeded last fall is estimated at 880,000 acres, up 35 percent from the previous year. Area planted to **oats** is expected to total 45,000 acres, down 25 percent from 2022. Producers intend to harvest 345,000 acres of **all hay** in 2023, down 30 percent from last year.
