

# **Illinois Hogs and Pigs**

#### Released June 29, 2023

**Illinois inventory** of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2023 was 5.40 million head, up 1 percent from March 1, 2023 and up 3 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 670,000 head, was up 20,000 from the previous quarter and up 50,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 4.73 million head, was up 1 percent from last quarter and up 2 percent from last year.

**The March-May 2023 pig crop**, at 3.07 million head, was up 10 percent from 2022. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 270,000 head, up 10,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.35 for the March-May period, compared with 10.70 last year.


