



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2024

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 1.97 billion bushels, down slightly from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 1.10 billion bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 875 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 449 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 547 million bushels, up slightly from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 245 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 302 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 133 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 40.7 million bushels, up 36 percent from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 5.00 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 35.7 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 7.84 million bushels.
