



Illinois Grain Stocks

Released March 28, 2024

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 1.48 billion bushels, up 11 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 780 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 704 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 494 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 333 million bushels, up 23 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 170 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 163 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 217 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 30.8 million bushels, up 59 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 2.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 28.3 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 9.43 million bushels.
