


# FARM INCOME

## CASH RECEIPTS

Indiana farmers received \$11.8 billion in cash receipts from farm marketings in 2011, 22 percent above 2010. Cash receipts from crops were up 24 percent, and receipts for livestock were 15 percent above the previous year. Marketings of crops at \$8.54 billion, accounted for 72.2 percent of the total cash receipts in 2011 while livestock receipts, at \$3.29 billion, accounted for the remaining 27.8 percent. In the previous year crop receipts accounted for 70.5 percent and livestock 29.5 percent of total cash receipts.

Corn was the leading source of income for Indiana farmers in 2011 and amounted to \$4.85 billion. Soybeans were second at \$3.05 billion and meat animals were third with \$1.46 billion. Poultry and Eggs remained as the fourth leading contributor with \$1.05 billion and Dairy follows with \$738 million. These five commodity groups accounted for 94 percent of the 2011 cash receipts.
