


# FARM INCOME

## CASH RECEIPTS

Indiana farmers received \$12.7 billion in cash receipts from farm marketing's in 2014, 12 percent above 2013. Cash receipts from crops were up 8 percent, and receipts for livestock were 19 percent above the previous year. Marketings of crops at \$8.45 billion, accounted for 66.3 percent of the total cash receipts in 2014 while livestock receipts, at \$4.29 billion, accounted for the remaining 33.7 percent. In the previous year crop receipts accounted for 68.5 percent and livestock 31.5 percent of total cash receipts.

Corn was the leading source of income for Indiana farmers in 2014 and amounted to \$4.36 billion. Soybeans were second at \$3.44 billion and meat animals were third with \$1.78 billion. Poultry and Eggs remained as the fourth leading contributor with \$1.39 billion and Dairy follows with \$939 million. These five commodity groups accounted for almost 94 percent of the 2014 cash receipts.
