


FARM INCOME

CASH RECEIPTS

Indiana farmers received \$10.6 billion in cash receipts from farm marketing's in 2017, 6 percent above 2016. Cash receipts from crops were up 4 percent, and receipts for livestock were 10 percent above the previous year. Marketing's of crops at \$6.91 billion, accounted for 64.9 percent of the total cash receipts in 2017 while livestock receipts, at \$3.73 billion, accounted for the remaining 35.1 percent. In the previous year crop receipts accounted for 66.3 percent and livestock 33.7 percent of total cash receipts.

Corn was the leading source of income for Indiana farmers in 2017 and amounted to \$3.28 billion. Soybeans were second at \$3.08 billion and meat animals remained in third place with \$1.62 billion. Poultry and eggs was the fourth leading contributor with \$1.18 billion and Dairy follows with \$750 million. These five commodity groups accounted for almost 93 percent of the 2017 cash receipts.
