## LIVESTOCK HIGHLIGHTS

**HOG AND PIG** numbers (December 1, 2021), at 4.35 million, were down 2 percent from a year earlier. The average value per head increased from \$106.00 in 2020 to \$115.00 in 2021. This raised the total inventory value to \$500.3 million, 6 percent above a year ago. Indiana remained in fifth place in the nation for the number of hogs on hand December 1, 2021.

**CATTLE** inventory numbers, at 810,000, were down 5 percent from January 1, 2021, and value per head increased to \$1,060 per head, up \$80.00 from the previous year. Total cattle inventory value, at \$858.6 million, increased 3 percent from the \$833.0 million last year. Cows and heifers that have calved totaled 370,000 head, down 1 percent from a year earlier. Of this total, 184,000 were beef cows, unchanged; and 186,000 were milk cows, down 3 percent from the previous year.

Total **SHEEP** inventory, at 60,000 head for January 1, 2022, was unchanged from a year earlier. Breeding sheep totaled 52,000 head. Average value per head, at \$259.00, was up \$15.00 from 2021. Total inventory value, at \$15.5 million, was 6 percent above the previous year.

Total **CHICKEN** inventory, excluding broilers, on December 1, 2021, at 45.6 million birds, was up 2 percent from the previous year. With this inventory, Indiana moved to third place in the nation for total chickens, excluding broilers, and for layers (35.5 million). The total value of the chicken inventory was \$136.8 million, up 6 percent from 2020. The value per bird, at \$3.00, was up \$0.10 from the previous year.
