Indiana Vegetable Report

Tomato processors contracted 7,200 acres in Indiana for 2015, a decrease of 2,100 acres from last year, according to Greg Matli, State Statistician, of the USDA, NASS, Indiana Field Office. Processing tomato production is forecast at 208,800 tons, down 39 percent from 2014. Nationally, contracted tomato acreage is 307,700, up 5,600 acres from last year's contracted acreage.
