



# News Release

## October Milk Production

Dairy herds in Indiana produced 339 million pounds of milk during October, up 4.0 percent from a year ago, according to Greg Matli, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Indiana Field Office. The daily rate per cow was 59.7 pounds, up 1.0 pound from October 2014. The dairy herd was estimated at 183,000 head for October, up 4,000 head from a year earlier.

Milk production in the 23 major States during October totaled 16.0 billion pounds, up 0.1 percent from October 2014. The daily production per cow in the 23 major States averaged 59.9 pounds in October, down 0.2 pounds from October 2014. The number of milk cows on farms in the 23 major States was 8.63 million head, 38,000 head more than October 2014, but 1,000 head less than September 2015.
