June Milk Production

Dairy herds in Indiana produced 354 million pounds of milk during June, down 0.6 percent from a year ago, according to Greg Matli, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Indiana Field Office. The daily rate per cow was 63.5 pounds, unchanged from June 2017. The dairy herd was estimated at 186,000 head for June, down 1,000 head from a year earlier.

Milk production in the 23 major States during June totaled 17.2 billion pounds, up 1.3 percent from June 2017. The daily production per cow in the 23 major States averaged 65.5 pounds for June, 0.8 pounds above June 2017. The number of milk cows on farms in the 23 major States was 8.75 million head, 12,000 head more than June 2017, but unchanged from May 2018.
