October Milk Production

Dairy herds in Indiana produced 340 million pounds of milk during October, down 4.8 percent from a year ago, according to Greg Matli, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Indiana Field Office. The daily rate per cow was 60.3 pounds, down 1.3 pounds from October 2017. The dairy herd was estimated at 182,000 head for October, down 5,000 head from a year earlier.

Milk production in the 23 major States during October totaled 16.9 billion pounds, up 1.0 percent from October 2017. The daily production per cow in the 23 major States averaged 62.4 pounds for October, up 1.0 percent from October 2017. The number of milk cows on farms in the 23 major States was 8.72 million head, 8,000 head less than October 2017, and 1,000 head less than September 2018.
