- Production of corn
- Production of soybeans

- Harvested acreage of principal crops
- Value of Field and Miscellaneous crops
- Hogs & Pigs inventory
- Value of hogs on farms
- Commercial hog slaughter
- Egg production

Iowa is ranked number two in:

- Cash receipts from farm marketings
- Capacity of commercial grain storage facilities
- Principal crops total value
- Pig crop inventory
- Red meat production
