KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 26, 2018 – For the month of February 2018, topsoil moisture supplies rated 36 percent very short, 38 short, 22 adequate, and 4 surplus, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 26 percent very short, 45 short, 28 adequate, and 1 surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 13 percent very poor, 36 poor, 39 fair, 11 good, and 1 excellent.

Weekly reports will begin March 5th for the 2018 season.

Data for this release were provided at the county level by USDA Farm Service agency and KSU Extension Service, and other reporters across the State.
