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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. March 4, 2019 - For the week ending March 3, 2019, topsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 2 short, 54 adequate, and 44 surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 1 short, 74 adequate, and 25 surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 2 percent very poor, 7 poor, 42 fair, 41 good, and 8 excellent.
