## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. March 11, 2019** - For the week ending March 10, 2019, there were 0.9 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 1 short, 55 adequate, and 44 surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 1 short, 71 adequate, and 28 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 2 percent very poor, 7 poor, 40 fair, 43 good, and 8 excellent.
