## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. December 9, 2019** - For the week ending December 8, 2019, there were 5.9 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 11 percent very short, 39 short, 48 adequate, and 2 surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 10 percent very short, 31 short, 57 adequate, and 2 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 6 percent very poor, 18 poor, 38 fair, 35 good, and 3 excellent. Winter wheat emerged was 94 percent.

Cotton harvested was 82 percent.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 5 percent very poor, 12 poor, 30 fair, 48 good, and 5 excellent.

This is the last weekly Crop Progress and Condition report for the 2019 growing season. We would like to extend our appreciation to the dedicated county FSA and extension staff who supplied the necessary information for these reports. For December through February, we will issue monthly reports. The first monthly report (for December) will be issued January 2, 2020. Weekly reports will begin March 2<sup>nd</sup> for the 2020 season.
