### KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. April 13, 2020** - For the week ending April 12, 2020, there were 6.2 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 5 percent very short, 20 short, 69 adequate, and 6 surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 6 percent very short, 14 short, 74 adequate, and 6 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 4 percent very poor, 11 poor, 35 fair, 44 good, and 6 excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 34 percent, ahead of 22 last year, but behind 40 for the five-year average.

Corn planted was 6 percent, near 5 last year and 10 average.
