KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. November 16, 2020 - For the week ending November 15, 2020, there were 6.1 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 23% very short, 41% short, 35% adequate, and 1% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 22% very short, 43% short, 34% adequate, and 1% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 6% very poor, 17% poor, 45% fair, 29% good, and 3% excellent. Winter wheat emerged was 88%, near 84% last year and 87% for the five-year average.

Corn harvested was 97%, near 94% last year and 95% average.

Soybeans harvested was 95%, ahead of 89% last year and 90% average.

Sorghum harvested was 91%, near 90% last year, and ahead of 84% average.

Cotton condition rated 6% very poor, 14% poor, 33% fair, 42% good, and 5% excellent. Cotton harvested was 42%, near 39% last year, and ahead of 37% average.

Sunflowers harvested was 91%, near 89% last year, and ahead of 80% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 12% very poor, 25% poor, 40% fair, 22% good, and 1% excellent.
