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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 22, 2021 - For the week ending February 21, 2021, topsoil moisture supplies rated 15% very short, 27% short, 51% adequate, and 7% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 15% very short, 29% short, 52% adequate and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 8% very poor, 18% poor, 34% fair, 37% good, and 3% excellent.

Weekly reports will begin March 1st for the 2021 season.
