KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 24, 2021 - For the week ending May 23, 2021, there were 2.2 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 1% very short, 8% short, 73% adequate, and 18% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 2% very short, 12% short, 75% adequate, and 11% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 11% poor, 30% fair, 44% good, and 11% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 84%, near 81% last year and 85% for the five-year average. Coloring was 2%, near 5% last year.

Corn planted was 76%, behind 85% last year, and near 80% average. Emerged was 56%, near 58% last year and 57% average.

Soybeans planted was 51%, near 50% last year, and ahead of 36% average. Emerged was 27%, equal to last year, and ahead of 18% average.

Sorghum planted was 12%, near 14% last year and 9% average.

Cotton planted was 39%, behind 50% last year, but ahead of 27% average.

Sunflowers planted was 14%, behind 26% last year, but ahead of 8% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 1% very poor, 7% poor, 32% fair, 54% good, and 6% excellent.
