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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 22, 2022 - For the week ending February 20, 2022, topsoil moisture supplies rated 45% very short, 34% short, 20% adequate, and 1% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 39% very short, 38% short, 23% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 10% very poor, 25% poor, 39% fair, 25% good, and 1% excellent.

Weekly reports will begin February 28th for the 2022 season.
