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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 24, 2022 - For the week ending January 23, 2022, topsoil moisture supplies rated 39% very short, 38% short, 22% adequate, and 1% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 31% very short, 41% short, 28% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 8% very poor, 23% poor, 39% fair, 29% good, and 1% excellent.

The next report is currently scheduled to be issued February 22, 2022 but may change due to the federal holiday on February 21st.
