KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 31, 2023 - For the week ending July 30, 2023, there were 6.4 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 36% short, 49% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 16% very short, 33% short, 50% adequate, and 1% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat harvested was 95%, behind 100% last year, and near 99% for the five-year average.

Corn condition rated 6% very poor, 12% poor, 32% fair, 40% good, and 10% excellent. Corn silking was 82%, ahead of 72% last year, and equal to average. Dough was 39%, ahead of 28% last year, and equal to average.

Soybean condition rated 7% very poor, 13% poor, 31% fair, 41% good, and 8% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 76%, ahead of 63% last year and 67% average. Setting pods was 38%, ahead of 23% last year, and near 34% average.

Sorghum condition rated 3% very poor, 10% poor, 33% fair, 44% good, and 10% excellent. Sorghum headed was 27%, ahead of 20% last year, but near 30% average. Coloring was 7%, ahead of 1% last year and 2% average.

Cotton condition rated 1% very poor, 4% poor, 34% fair, 42% good, and 19% excellent. Cotton squaring was 90%, behind 98% last year, but near 86% average. Setting bolls was 53%, behind 58% last year, but well ahead of 31% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 9% very poor, 21% poor, 38% fair, 27% good, and 5% excellent.
