KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. October 2, 2023 - For the week ending October 1, 2023, there were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 33% very short, 39% short, 28% adequate, and 0% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 37% very short, 39% short, 24% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat planted was 37%, ahead of 28% last year, but near 38% for the five-year average. Emerged was 14%, ahead of 6% last year, but near 15% average.

Corn condition rated 15% very poor, 18% poor, 34% fair, 26% good, and 7% excellent. Corn mature was 93%, ahead of 81% last year and 85% average. Harvested was 51%, near 48% last year, and ahead of 42% average.

Soybean condition rated 20% very poor, 30% poor, 32% fair, 16% good, and 2% excellent. Soybeans dropping leaves was 79%, ahead of 66% last year and 65% average. Harvested was 24%, ahead of 18% last year and 11% average.

Sorghum condition rated 11% very poor, 19% poor, 38% fair, 28% good, and 4% excellent. Sorghum coloring was 94%, near 91% last year and 95% average. Mature was 60%, ahead of 50% last year and 54% average. Harvested was 19%, ahead of 9% last year and 11% average.

Cotton condition rated 6% very poor, 17% poor, 42% fair, 31% good, and 4% excellent. Cotton bolls opening was 91%, ahead of 74% last year, and well ahead of 63% average. Harvested was 5%, near 6% last year and 2% average.

Sunflowers harvested was 23%, ahead of 4% last year and 5% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 23% very poor, 28% poor, 35% fair, 13% good, and 1% excellent.
