KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. December 4, 2023 - For the week ending December 3, 2023, there were 4.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 22% very short, 30% short, 39% adequate, and 9% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 29% very short, 37% short, 32% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 11% very poor, 15% poor, 34% fair, 35% good, and 5% excellent. Winter wheat emerged was 96%, ahead of 89% last year, and near 93% for the five-year average.

Cotton harvested was 92%, near 94% last year, but ahead of 73% average.

Sunflowers harvested was 97%, near 100% last year, and equal to average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 16% very poor, 26% poor, 38% fair, 18% good, and 2% excellent.
