KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. September 2, 2025 - For the week ending August 31, 2025, there were 3.9 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 16% short, 66% adequate, and 14% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 21% short, 65% adequate, and 8% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 3% very poor, 10% poor, 28% fair, 44% good, and 15% excellent. Corn dough was 96%, near 95% last year and 93% for the five-year average. Dented was 72%, near 74% last year and 71% average. Mature was 29%, behind 34% last year, but near 26% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 6% poor, 27% fair, 55% good, and 11% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 95%, equal to last year and near 96% average. Setting pods was 85%, equal to last year and average. Dropping leaves was 7%, near 10% last year and average.

Sorghum condition rated 4% very poor, 8% poor, 28% fair, 45% good, and 15% excellent. Sorghum headed was 93%, near 92% last year and 91% average. Coloring was 49%, near 51% last year and 46% average. Mature was 12%, near 13% last year, but ahead of 6% average.

Cotton condition rated 1% very poor, 7% poor, 29% fair, 42% good, and 21% excellent. Bolls opening was 16%, behind 35% last year and 26% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 9% poor, 25% fair, 50% good, and 12% excellent.
